70. Narrative

OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A SINGLE VEHICLE CRASH NEAR EXIT 85 ON I 65 NORTHBOUND. SEVERAL WITNESSES CALLED REGARDING A MALE WHITE IN A WHITE SHIRT AND BLUE JEANS WITH A BACKPACK WALKING AROUND THE INTERSTATE AND A VEHICLE IN THE DITCH AT THIS LOCATION. THE SUBJECT APPROACHED AN OFFICER'S VEHICLE WHILE THEY WERE ON A SEPARATE CALL FOR SERVICE FURTHER SOUTH DOWN THE INTERSTATE. THE OFFICER STATED THE SUBJECT APPROACHED THE PATROL BEFORE SLUMPING OVER ON TO IT. OFFICERS DETERMINED HIM TO BE THE INDIVIDUAL FROM THE SINGLE VEHICLE CRASH. OFFICERS ASKED THE SUBJECT IF THAT WAS HIS VEHICLE IN THE DITCH, TO WHICH HE INITIALLY ANSWERED NO BUT EVENTUALLY CONFIRMED THE BLACK RAM TO BE HIS VEHICLE. OFFICERS COULD SMELL THE ODOR OF ALCOHOL COMING FROM THE SUBJECT AS THEY SPOKE WITH HIM. WHEN SPEAKING WITH OFFICERS, THE SUBJECT WOULD ONLY ANSWER QUESTIONS WITH "YES" OR "CORRECT" EVEN WHEN ASKED WHAT HIS NAME AND BIRTHDAY WERE. OFFICERS OBSERVED THE SUBJECT SWAYING WHILE STANDING STILL TALKING TO MEDICS, AND WHEN THE SUBJECT EXITED THE PATROL CAR TO WALK TO THE STRETCHER TO BE MEDICALLY CLEARED, THE SUBJECT WAS UNSTEADY ON HIS FEET AND STUMBLED TO THE POINT OF OFFICERS HAVING TO ASSIST HIM TO THE STRETCHER. ONCE THE SUBJECT WAS MEDICALLY CLEARED, THE SUBJECT WAS TRANSPORTED TO 2010 ROSA L PARKS BLVD TO PERFORM STANDARD FIELD SOBRIETY TESTS. THE SUBJECT DISPLAYED LACK OF SMOOTH PURSUIT AND NYSTAGMUS ONSET PRIOR TO FORTY FIVE DEGREES. THE SUBJECT WAS ALSO UNABLE TO FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS TO KEEP HIS HANDS AT HIS SIDE AND HIS HEAD STILL. THE SUBJECT CONTINUED TO FOLLOW THE STIMULUS WITH HIS HEAD AND CONTINUED TO SWAY IN PLACE. THE SUBJECT ALSO NEARLY FELL ONTO OFFICERS WHILE ATTEMPTING TO FOLLOW THE STIMULUS. OFFICERS DETERMINED HE WOULD BE UNABLE TO COMPLETE THE WALK AND TURN AND ONE LEG STAND DUE TO OFFICERS CONSISTENTLY HAVING TO SUPPORT HIM FROM FALLING OR STUMBLING OVER. THE SUBJECT WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY WITHOUT INCIDENT AND MIRANDIZED. UNDER MIRANDA, OFFICERS ATTEMPTED TO ASK THE SUBJECT HOW MUCH AND WHAT HE HAD BEEN DRINKING, BUT THE SUBJECT WOULD ONLY RESPOND WITH "CORRECT". SUBJECT CONSENTED TO A BREATH TEST. SUBJECT'S BAC WAS .261.
